

UMass Productivity Kit: Allowing Pop-up Windows for UPK



This job aid provides step by step instructions on allowing pop-up windows in the following browsers: Internet Explorer 6.0, Internet Explorer 7.0, and Firefox 3.0.6.



In order to use the online tutorials through UPK, you must have the following browsers:

- PC machine: Internet Explorer 5.5 or later
- Mac machine: Firefox Version 3.0.3 or later

Internet Explorer 6.0 (PC Machine)

Navigate to Internet Explorer ().

Step 2.

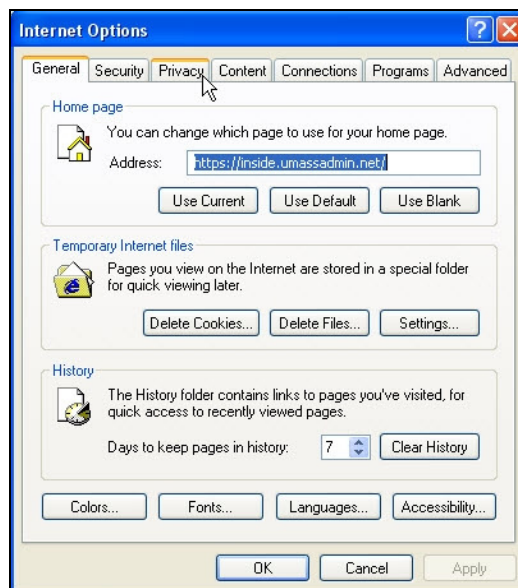
Click on Tools in the browser navigation menu. The **Tools** dropdown list opens.










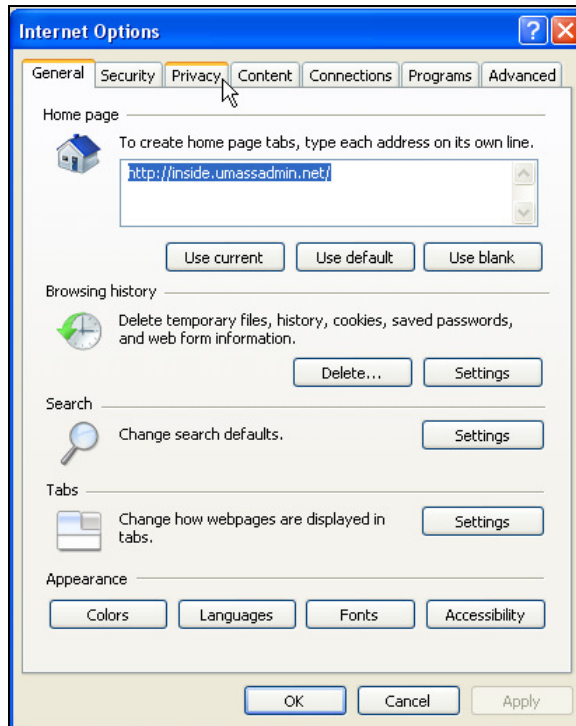
Click on Internet Options.

<p>Step 6.</p>	<p>Enter the UPK Environment link into the Address of Web Site to allow field: http://upk.umassp.edu.</p>

<p>Step 8.</p>	<p>Click the  button. The Pop-up Blocker Settings window closes.</p> <p>The Internet Options window remains open.</p>

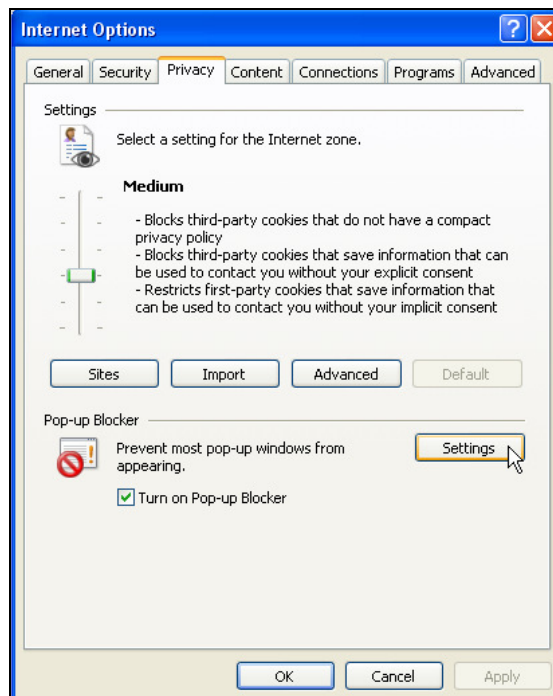

<p>Step 12.</p>	<p>Click on Internet Options.</p> <p>The Internet Options window opens.</p>














Click on the Privacy tab.






The Privacy tab opens.
